

**Articles of Incorporation
of
HOMESCHOOL ACADEMY OF SOUTH JERSEY
A Non-Profit Corporation
Amended September 27, 2005**

Pursuant to the provision of the Nonprofit Corporation Act of this state, the undersigned incorporators hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1

The name of this corporation is **Homeschool Academy of South Jersey.**

Article 2

The name and address of the registered agent and registered office of this corporation is:

Article 3

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are: is to provide students with academic classes to enrich and fulfill New Jersey educational requirements.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Homeschool Academy admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school-administered programs.

Article 4

Article 5

The name(s) and address(es) of the incorporator(s) of this corporation is/are:

Article 6

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

Article 7

The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications and obligations of members of this corporation are as follows: The membership provisions of this corporation shall be stated in the Bylaws of this corporation.

Article 8

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the General Corporation Law of New Jersey.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.


No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statement) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501 (c)(3) purposes.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The undersigned incorporators hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the statements made in the foregoing Articles of Incorporation are true.
